George I. Mantanis is a senior faculty member at Department of Forestry, Wood Sciences and Design, University of Thessaly, Greece. He is presently head of the Laboratory of Wood Science & Technology. Through the years 2002-2019, he worked in the former TEI of Thessaly, Department of Wood & Furniture Design and Technology. He holds a PhD degree in wood science (1994) from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. He worked as wood technologist in the Forest Research Institute of Thessaloniki (1996-1997), and also, as a research scientist in the R&D department of former ACM Wood Chemicals Plc group (1998-2001), today Chimar Hellas SA. He teaches the courses "Wood structure", "Wood properties", "Chemical technology of wood", and also the elective course, "Identification of wood". Since 2018, he serves as a Co-Editor in the referred wood journal "Wood Material Science and Engineering" (impact factor of year 2021: 2.732) of Taylor & Francis. He acts as a reviewer in the referred journals, "Holzforschung", "European Journal of Wood and Wood Products", "BioResources" and "Wood Science & Technology". He frequently columns in the technical Greek magazine "Ktirio". In the years 2020, 2021 and 2022, for his recognised research work, his name was included in *Mendeley Data* in the area Materials/Forestry. Notably in 2021, he was honoured by being elected a *Fellow* in the International Academy of Wood Science (IAWS).
